

Workshop Activities

Music with Founder/Director Kelly Takunda Orphan

Come and sing songs from around the world. Learn choral technique and many summer songs to uplift the spirit. Let your voice be heard through the medium of music.

Dance

Students will have an opportunity to learn the African way of dancing and they will also learn where the dances come from and why they are performed.

Visual Arts

Explore color, design, multi-media or a group mural celebrating “the vision in our mind”. Projects may include written word and poetry infused with visual arts.

Percussion

Come and play congas, djembes, and other percussion instruments. Explore rhythm and expression through percussion.

Creative Movement and Music

Students get to improvise and create their own movements and songs. Emphasis of this class is to honor and celebrate the uniqueness of each child’s authentic expression.

 **Enrollment** is limited to 30 kids per session (kindergarten - fifth grade). First-come, first-served. Children must have completed kindergarten to attend.

Enrollment is limited to five Junior Interns (6th through 8th grade). Junior Interns get to support the younger students in their classes and they get a special opportunity to meet with the teachers as a group and create their own art project. Interns receive a 50% discount on fees (\$140. per session or \$280. for both sessions before May 1st).
